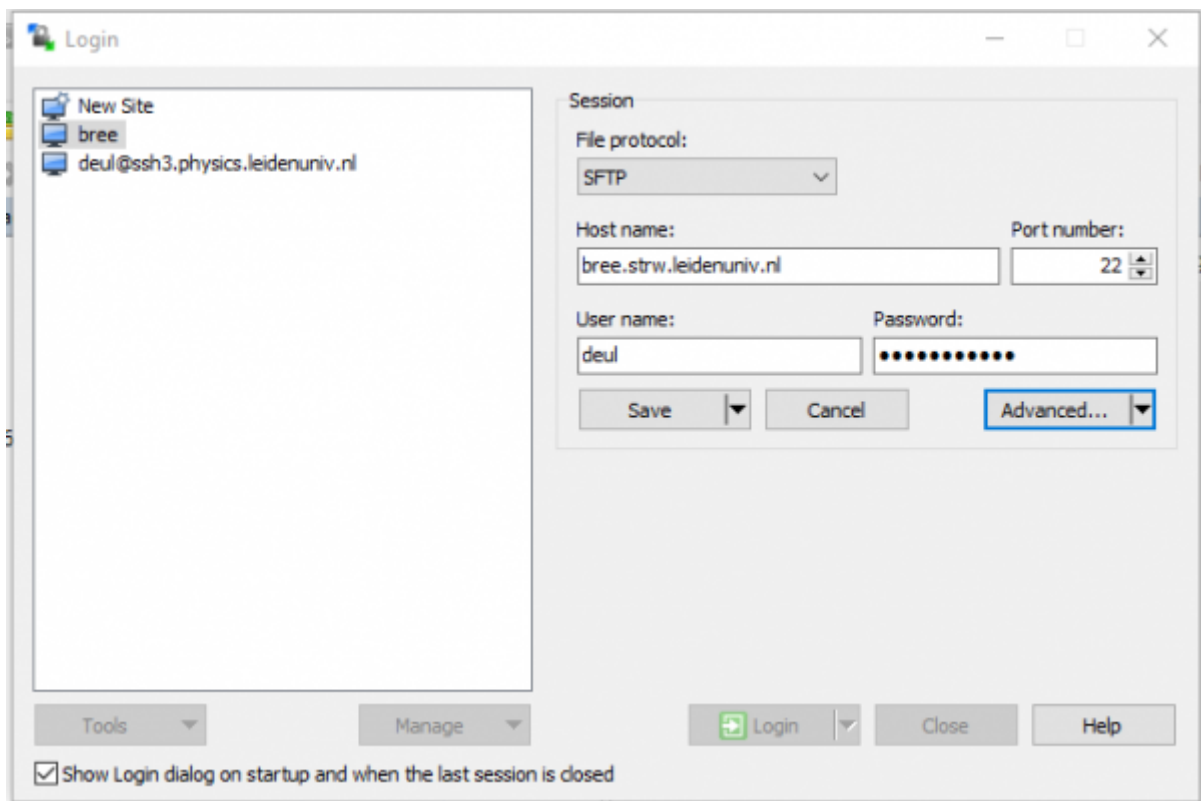


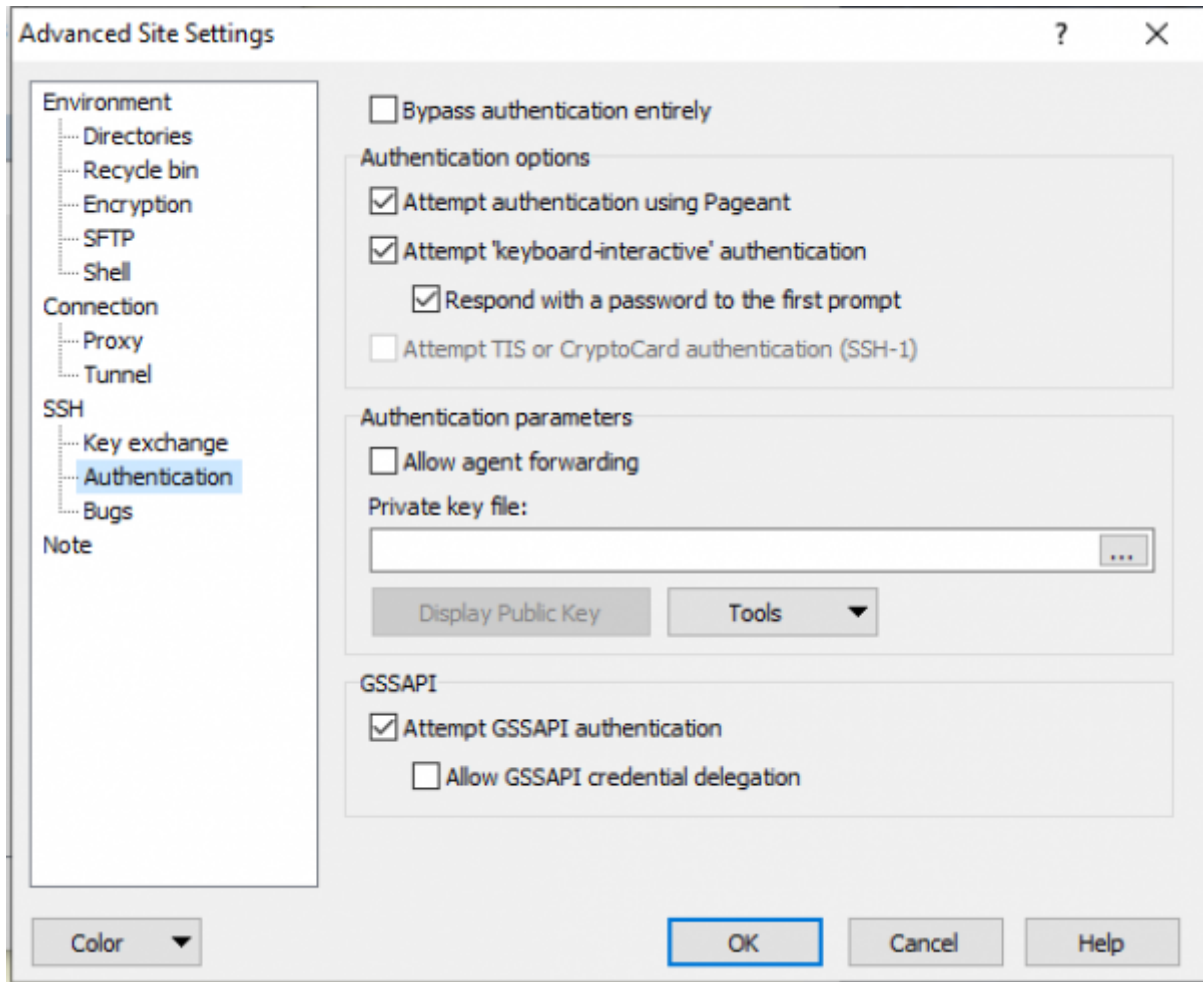
Setup WinSCP for file copy

Before you can setup WinSCP with a key pair, you need to perform the necessary actions for putty key based access ([see here](#)).

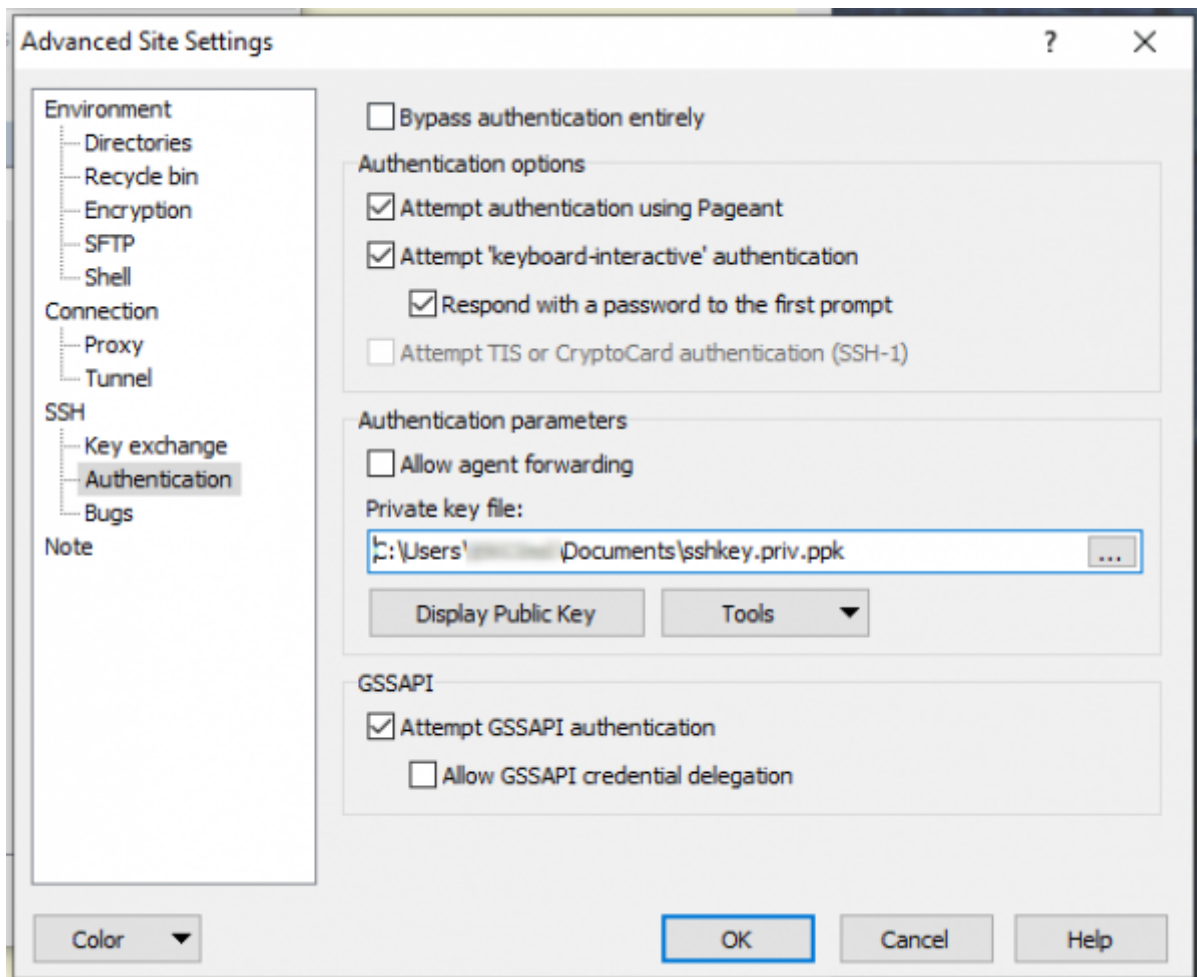
So you should already have a private key somewhere on your directory structure. This private key will now be added to your WinSCP setup. Open the WinSCP programs, select the saved profile to which you want to add the private key:



Then click **Advanced** to open the configuration window:



Select Authenticate under SSH and then you see halfway down the right part of the window a textbox named **Private Key File**:. Click the Browse button and select your private key file:



Once selected, click **OK** to save this setting and when back on the main window, click **Save** to save this new setting in the profile.

Now you are ready to transfer files password/2fa code free.
